About Big Lake Middle School

- To ease the transition to middle school, sixth graders are assigned to teams. This configuration allows students to attend classes with the same group of students all year.
- Districtwide focus on citizenship is taken up a notch at the middle school with a line up of enrichment classes such as interpersonal communications, mentoring, civil citizenship, mindset matters, service learning projects, teen life, and many more.
- Project Lead the Way (PLTW) classes are in full force with three unit offerings: computer science, design/modeling and automation/robotics. These courses help students develop essential skills for the 21st Century such as critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, and communication. Students are exposed to many robot challenges and 3D printing opportunities.
- As a Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) school, staff encourage good behavior and focus on prevention, not punishment. The PBIS behavior model has dramatically minimized negative behaviors contributing to a welcoming environment for all learners.
- Offers a wide variety of after-school activities such as Geography Bee, Knowledge Bowl, Math Masters, Student Council, and 20+ MN High School League athletics.

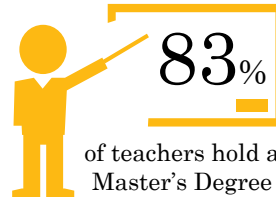
